

DEMERARA 23 y . o . 1990-2014

Appearance Warm amber.

Nose Somehow similar in intensity to extra old

Jamaican rums, then it becomes more winey, rich with dried grapes and musky

notes. Sweet and deep.

Palate Elegant softness and chewy character.

Medicinal herbs, coffee, cinchona, cola and cinnamon. Not overly sweet, thanks to the

rich winey notes from the sherry.

Finish Warm, soft aftertaste, with winey and spicy

notes and a fragrance like dried figs. This release too has echoes of Barolo Chinato or

mulled wine.

Comment Even softer and more elegant than

1989-2012 release, with more marked oloroso

sherry notes: it is very reminiscent of old

Speyside whiskies.
