

MARTINIQUE Hors d'Age

Appearance Amber-coloured like a Bas Armagnac.

Nose Wine-like, with a pleasant alcoholic hint that tickles the nostrils, sharper aromas of coffee powder and liquorice creep up later.

- PalateThe first impact is hot and alcoholic, with
excellent volume, after it is only sweet notes
of butter and sugar cane, with a hint of
white chocolate.
- *Finish Full, warm, it ends with a dry finale of great length.*

Comment The characteristics of Rhum agricole, distilled from the juice of sugar cane, then "vesou" fermented, reveal themselves in all their glory in this liqueur; an admirable example of the produce of the French Islands.
