



MARTINIQUE *Hors d'Age*

Appearance *Amber-coloured like a Bas Armagnac.*

Nose *Wine-like, with a pleasant alcoholic hint that tickles the nostrils, sharper aromas of coffee powder and liquorice creep up later.*

Palate *The first impact is hot and alcoholic, with excellent volume, after it is only sweet notes of butter and sugar cane, with a hint of white chocolate.*

Finish *Full, warm, it ends with a dry finale of great length.*

Comment *The characteristics of Rhum agricole, distilled from the juice of sugar cane, then “vesou” fermented, reveal themselves in all their glory in this liqueur; an admirable example of the produce of the French Islands.*
